

Credit Recovery Options

A+

A+ is a computer program available at EHHS on our computers. Students must complete their A+ work at school, either during free time (i.e. lunch) or during an assigned class period. The fee for having A+ as a class period is \$30.

Most core classes are available on A+, but there are few art, P.E., and elective classes. CTE and computer technology are not available on A+. Students are expected to use A+ for credit recovery only, unless a class is available on A+ that we otherwise don't offer (such as Physics).

To sign up for A+, see Jennifer in the counseling office.

Electronic High School (EHS)

EHS is available to all Utah students. There is no tuition for this program, although students are expected to supply their own books. Sometimes books can be checked out of a library or borrowed from our school. EHS is an internet-based program so students can work on it anytime they have internet access.

EHS requires students to be motivated and be able to problem solve, since the program is completely separate from our school. Most classes require a proctored final test to be taken. If you want to take a final, you can schedule a time with Jennifer, who is an EHS proctor. To set up an account, go to www.ehs.uen.org. Click on "create account." Be sure to write down or memorize your password. Classes available are listed on the same website.

BYU Independent Study

This is another option for making up a variety of credits online. This program also includes many classes we may not offer at our school. However, the cost of classes is \$126 for .5 credits, or \$80 for .25 credits, plus books and fees. To register, go to www.elearn.byu.edu.

Other options

For students who are short general (elective) credit, work experience or independent P.E. can provide a way to earn additional credits outside a normal schedule. Core classes may also be retaken with teacher approval, providing there is room in the class. See Jennifer for more information.
